

House Badge Application Instructions

You will need

- 1: your blazer**
- 2: your house badge**
- 3: an iron**
- 4: some kitchen paper**
- 5: a sturdy flat surface – a low coffee table is ideal**

Switch on your iron, set it on the medium temperature setting (160C) and allow it to warm-up for a couple of minutes. If it is a steam iron make sure the water tank is empty.

While the iron is warming drape the blazer on the table so that the lapel can be pressed against the work surface rather than the body of the jacket.

Position the badge on the lapel and cover with the sheet of kitchen paper.

Press the badge as firmly as you can for 30 seconds. Concentrate on the edges of the badge and avoid direct contact where possible with the fabric of the blazer.

Then repeat the process from the reverse side of the lapel for a further 60 seconds.

Check that you are happy with the finish. If the adhesive has not melted properly repeat the second part of the pressing process until you are satisfied.

The heat bond takes around 24 hours to reach its maximum strength.
