

“Attitude to Learning” Criteria

1	Outstanding Effort
1	<p>Always prepared to answer questions and/or contribute to discussion</p> <p>Always completes work to high standard</p> <p>Frequently reaches extension work</p> <p>Maximum effort each lesson</p> <p>Asks for extra work or comes back at lunchtime</p>
2	Good Effort
2	<p>Often prepared to answer questions and/or contribute to discussion</p> <p>Often completes work to high standard</p> <p>Sometimes reaches extension work</p> <p>Enthusiastic about their work</p>
3	Satisfactory Effort
3	<p>Does what is expected</p> <p>Works to an acceptable standard</p> <p>Makes useful contributions to lessons (even if they have to be prompted by staff)</p>
4	Unsatisfactory
4	<p>Work is often incomplete</p> <p>Completed work can be of a standard below what the student is capable of.</p> <p>Student needs occasional reminders to stay on task</p> <p>Minimal useful and/or appropriate contributions to lessons (questions/discussions)</p>
5	Poor
5	<p>Regularly fails to meet deadlines for completion of work.</p> <p>Concentration throughout majority of lessons is a poor standard</p> <p>Student needs regular reminders to stay on task</p> <p>No appropriate contributions made within lessons (questions/discussions)</p> <p>Does not respond to instructions & advice.</p>
